

Rules

1 Three Fish Stringer: one Trout, one Redfish & one Flounder.

- 1a. Trophies for 1st place stringer only.
- 1b. You don't need all 3 to win stringer.
- 1c. Total weight of 1, 2, or 3 fish brought to weigh-in.
- 1d. Only three fish can be brought to weigh-in. If you have a fish that gets disqualified, you cannot replace it with another fish.
- 1e. All three fish must meet legal Texas Parks & Wildlife lengths.
- 1f. No oversized Red Fish.
- 1g. Trout are 15"-20" Slot
- 1h. All legal LIVE fish weighed-in will receive a 1/2 lb. BONUS.
- 1i. All legal DEAD redfish and flounder weighed-in will receive a 1/2 lb. DEDUCTION

2 Cash Pots

- 2a. The Pots are not included in registration fee.
- 2b. If you do not pay cash to enter the Pots during Registration on Friday night, you will not be eligible to win the prize money.
- 2c. The top fish in each category will receive a trophy and the three pots pay for the top three (3) places, in each Division.
- 2d. The same Trout, Redfish and Flounder will ALSO be used in Big Trout, Redfish and Flounder pots.
- 2e. All pots to be split 50% for 1st, 30% for 2nd, and 20% for 3rd.

3 Division & Team Rules

- 3a. Men's Pro and Amateur Divisions: Four (4) people per team per boat in both the Pro and Amateur Divisions. You may hire a guide to fish the Pro Division, but he/she counts as one of your 4 anglers.
- 3b. Definition of a "Pro" Team: A team with at least one member who has held a Guide License, has fished the FLW Tour, Texas Trout & Redfish Series (Baffin Bay Bashes, etc.).
- 3c. Definition of an Amateur Team: Four anglers who have never held a Guide License or fished in a Pro Tournament.
- 3d. Women's Open Division: Four (4) women per team for the Women's Division, a guide or driver can be on the boat but may not fish. This is an open class with no differentiation between pro and amateur.
- 3e. Live Bait is ONLY acceptable in the Women's Open Division
- 3f. Amateur and Pro Divisions can ONLY use artificial lures.
- 3g. Each team will be given a "chip" and a start time at the Captain's meeting.
- 3h. Each team must check-in at the dock in the morning at the time specified and leave in the order drawn. If you do not check-in, you will be disqualified. No exceptions.

4 This is a Bay Fishing Tournament. (jetties & surf fishing are prohibited)

5 Fish and Travel Safely

- 5a. Use the kill switch while motoring
- 5b. The use of life jackets is the Boat Captain's discretion, but highly recommended
- 5c. All anglers must stay in clear sight of the boat while wading (This is required from a safety standpoint and helps increase your odds of keeping your fish alive).

6 Tournament goes on rain or shine, no refunds. However, in the event of inclement weather, and at the sole discretion of the Tournament Director, the start may be delayed and/or the weigh-in times adjusted.

7 The Weigh Master makes all final decisions on any disputes.

8 All Tie Breakers to be determined in this order

- 8a. LIVE fish vs. DEAD fish
- 8b. Weight of Trout
- 8c. Length of Trout
- 8d. If it's still a tie, it will be decided by the flip of a coin

9 All winners are subject to a lie detector test

10 All anglers must sign a release form before fishing in the tournament

ALL RULES ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE.

It is your responsibility to make sure at least one member of your team is present at the Captain's Meeting, where changes will be announced.
